Preparing Your Tween for Middle School

Ask About Concerns

Be sure to give your child numerous opportunities to ask questions about his/her new experience and express concerns. You may think your child is stressed about changing classes, when he/she may really be worried about whether or not he'll/she'll remember his/her locker combination.

Assess Your Child's Skills and Abilities

Starting all over at a new school is hard enough, but starting over when you're struggling with math or reading can make the experience a nightmare. Consider tutoring services if your child's academic skills aren't where they should be. Also, ask the middle school about any resources they may provide to help your child succeed academically.
